



Center for Bioanalytic Metrology: Three-Minute Thesis Competition

4:00 p.m. (ET), Wednesday, April 13, 2022

Graduate students from Indiana University Bloomington, Purdue University, and the University of Notre Dame are invited to compete for prizes in a three-minute thesis competition focused on any aspect of measurement science research. The competition is sponsored by the [Center for Bioanalytic Metrology](#) (CBM), an NSF Industry-University Cooperative Research Center that connects all three campuses.

Gift certificates will be awarded to the first place (\$250), second place (\$150), and third place (\$50) presentations, as judged by the center's Industry Advisory Board (IAB), which is comprised of representatives from [leading companies](#) in pharmaceuticals, agriculture, energy, and other industries.

The competition is being held in conjunction with the [CBM Spring IAB meeting](#), which will be a hybrid in-person/online meeting. Purdue students are encouraged to present in-person at the meeting at the [Convergence Center for Innovation & Collaboration](#) (101 Foundry Drive, West Lafayette, IN 47096). Indiana and Notre Dame students may also present in-person, though the center is not covering travel expenses at this time. Any student may present via Zoom, if they choose.

Rules:

1. Participants must use the template slide provided upon registration. No other slides, media, or aids are allowed.
2. Presentations must adhere to the three-minute time limit in order to be eligible for a prize.

Judging Criteria:

Presented projects will be evaluated on their (a) scientific impact, (b) clarity of presentation, and (c) technical proficiency.

Entry:

To sign-up for the competition, students should [REGISTER](#) for the meeting, where they will be prompted to enter their name and a title for their presentation. Registrants will then receive the approved slide template by email. Students must enter by April 8, 2022, in order to compete. Participation is limited to 25 students.
